

County Award - Girlguiding West Yorkshire South



The County Executive Committee agreed at their April Meeting 2012 to the introduction of a new County Award for volunteer members of Girlguiding West Yorkshire South This is for volunteers who have provided exceptional service within the County

The Award will have the design of the De Lacey Knot and will be a metal badge The knot will be gold/yellow on a blue background. The De Lacey Knot is one of the emblems on the County Standard. Each recipient will also receive a certificate

Any volunteer member of Girlguiding West Yorkshire South can nominate another volunteer for this award. The application must be supported by the Division Commissioner. A short statement should be written describing why you feel the volunteer should be a recipient of the Award and signed by yourself and the Division Commissioner. The nomination should then be sent to the County Commissioner. The application will be considered by the County Awards Committee.

The Criteria

- Hold a volunteer appointment in Girlguiding West Yorkshire South
- The volunteer should be a good team player as well as a good team leader.
- The volunteer should be playing a full role in their District and/or Division
- The volunteer will have helped girls to experience guiding activities beyond the unit. e.g. Residential events adventurous activities, outings
- The recipient will demonstrate that in whatever volunteer Guiding role they undertake they have integrity, commitment and enthusiasm.
- They will provide an inclusive Guiding programme.
- There will be evidence in the volunteer's role of their commitment to keeping the Guide Promise.
